

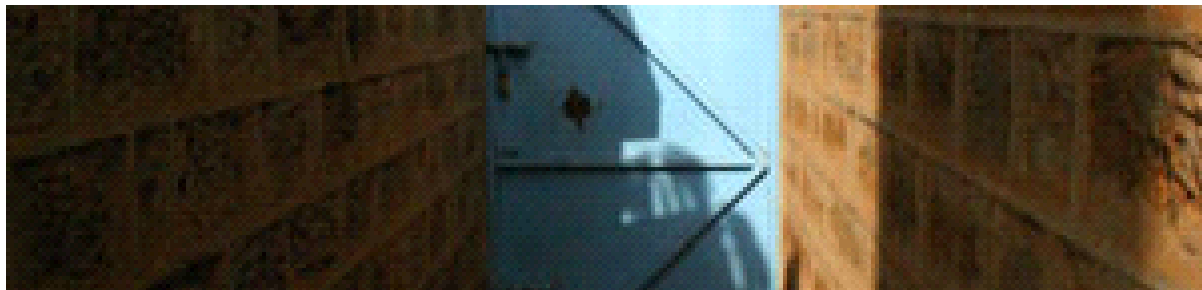


Sponsoring a Brighter Future



Life is hard for orphans in Kenya. Most people live on less than \$1 per day and many relatives can't afford to adopt them. Orphans of young single mothers or AIDS victims, suffer discrimination, abuse and neglect. They face a future of abject poverty, homelessness and starvation. If they survive, they lose out on education and are forced to work or beg to earn their keep. Young girls face an even bleaker future and may be forced into bonded labour or prostitution. Many will suffer serious illness and early death.

But in Thika, 30 miles north of Nairobi, behind a blue door is a small haven for abandoned children. Here 19 girls are cared for in a safe and loving environment. "The Thika Centre for Good Future" provides each child with food, shelter, education, health care and a home; free from conflict, abuse and exploitation.

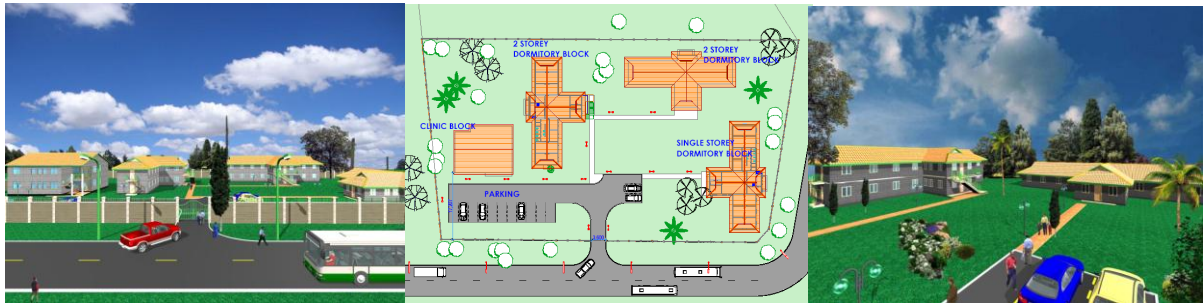


They arrived frightened, neglected and malnourished. After a thorough medical check, they were prescribed appropriate treatment and put on a controlled diet. After missing out on years of parental care, the housemothers welcomed them and gave them love and attention. A mentor was on hand to help them deal with their emotional problems, build their self confidence and develop their social skills. Volunteers gave them tuition at home until they reached the standard for admission to school.



Today they are healthy, happy, loved and doing well at school. They live as a family, eat and play together, do their homework and help out with the household chores. They go to local schools, sing in the choir and belong to the girls brigade. They have a daily structure, sense of purpose and a feeling of belonging. They are safe and have a bright future ahead of them.

Almost 50,000 young girls have been abandoned in Kenya (UNICEF). We want to help many more of them. We have been given an acre of land in Ngoingwa, near Thika, and we are constructing a new Centre in stages to accommodate up to 150 girls as well as providing a health clinic and a community centre for the poor people living nearby.
